Summary

This document describes how the sales information (MA016) custom control and controller works.

Description

The sales information form allows the user to view, create, modify or delete sales information. Also adding and deleting grantors and grantees are done via a custom control. These data are stored in the **MA_SALES** table.

Functionalities

Uses Sales Information (CAMA Sales) entity which needs a grantee/grantor custom control to manage grantors and grantees, and a controller for custom save/update/delete.

Controller

1. Custom Save

a. Before save

- Check if the number of parcel entered is valid.
- Initialize year id and frozen id.
 - If the attributes Year_ID and Frozen_ID are available, take them
 - Otherwise if there is a sale Id and a Sale available in the table, take it's Year_Id and frozen_Id
 - Otherwise, take the current fiscal year and the next Frozen Id like if it was a new sale
- Calculate Sale Ratio for a sale
- If this is a new sale then we set it as the current parcel id as the master id in the PC_LK_PARCEL_SALE table.

b. Execute open form save

c. After save

- Freezes the current parcel id and year id found in the current entity from the sales form
- If this is a new sale then set the default grantors

2. Custom Delete

a. Before delete

- Ask user for confirmation of deletion
- Gets the list of parcel IDs related to the given sale ID
- Deletes frozen related records for each related parcel
- The collateral records (Ex. Linked Parcels, grantors and grantees) will get deleted only if there is no sale and no deed for the sale id.

b. After delete

- Show user a delete completed message


3. Custom Create

- Set the year id to the current year id found in the govern ids
- Using the parcel id and year id we retrieve a frozen id for this new sale



Description

The new version of the custom control will use the save button of the open form to actually do the addition/deletion of grantors or grantees.

On load

We apply the security that was set for the current user in security manager.

Grantor

1. Auto create the grantors with the information of the current owners when clicking on the NEW button.
2. The ownership percentage of the grantor will be set with the ownership percentage of the owner. (Once SAVED, the percentage won't change even if the user go in the owner function to change the percentage)
3. The percentage in grantor is NOT editable if the owner percentage from PC_OWNER is set.
4. Can add new grantor using the add button on top of the grantor list.
5. Only always edit the percentage if the added new grantor is NOT a current owner.
6. Each grantor percentage must be between 1 and 100.
7. The total of the percent in the grantors must be maximum 100. Can be less than 100.
8. Can remove any grantor in the list.
9. The grantor list cannot be empty. Need to have at less 1 item.

Grantee

1. Can add new grantee using the Add button on top of the grantee list.
2. Only always edit the percentage in the grantee.
3. Each grantee percentage must be between 1 and 100.
4. The total percentage of the grantees must be the same as the total percentage of the grantors (maximum 100 and can be less than 100).
5. Can remove any grantee in the list.
6. The grantee list cannot be empty. Need to have at less 1 item.

Button Save

A brief description of the save process:

1. Validate the data and if there is an error show an error message in a prompt box
2. Get the current owners of the current parcel.
3. Save or update all the grantors found in the grantors list
4. Save or update all the grantees found in the grantees list
5. Delete grantors or grantees that were removed from the list
6. If the checkbox “Prevent update owners” is not checked then we update the owners of the linked parcels
7. If the checkbox “Prevent update mailing index” is not checked then we update the mailing index of the linked parcels
8. If the checkbox “Prevent update exemptions” is not checked then we set the current non-property based exemptions effective_until field on a property to the sale_date for each linked parcel
9. Show a save successful message



Button Add

Open the search window to allow the user to select one or multiple name to be added to the grantor/grantee list.

Button Remove

Remove the current selected grantor or grantee. The button will be enabled only if the user has the required permission and if a grantor or grantee is selected.

Linked parcels Custom control



Description

The new version of the custom control will use the save button of the open form to actually do the linking/unlinking of parcels for a sale.

On load

We apply the security that was set for the Add/Remove/Select buttons in security manager.

Validation

1. The sale percentage for a parcel cannot exceed 100 or be negative
2. The master parcel cannot be added as a link
3. If the total percentage sale amongst the linked parcel is greater than 100 we warn the user if they still want to continue the save
4. If the parcel id of a linked parcel is 0, then there was an error in the addition of link parcel
5. We check for duplicates in the linked parcels list
6. The total percentage sale amongst the linked parcel cannot be greater than 100

Button Save

A brief description of the save process:

1. Validate the data and if there is an error show an error message in a prompt box
2. Get the current grantees of the current sale record.
3. Get current owners of the current parcel
4. Save or update all the linked parcels found in the linked parcel list
 - For each add or updated linked parcel, check if the current owners and current grantees matches,
If yes,
 - We need to change ownership of the parcel with the grantees list.
 - We need update tax exemptions due to sale
 - We need to update parcel mailing index of a linked property to match that of the master parcel
5. Delete linked parcels that were removed from the list
 - For each deleted linked parcel we also delete frozen parcel from sale

6. For each frozen linked parcel we create a new frozen record of update the existing record
7. Calculate Sale Ratio and update the parent entity sale ratio
8. Show a save successful message

Button Add Parcel

Open the search window to allow the user to select one or multiple parcel to be added to the linked parcel list.

Button Remove Parcel

Remove the current selected linked parcel. The button will be enabled only if the user has the required permission and if a linked parcel is selected.

Button Select Parcel

Send the current select linked parcel to the Treeview and select it. The button will be enabled only if the user has the required permission and if a linked parcel is selected


